If this is the first time you have attended the Traditional Latin Mass, you may have noticed that our parishioners do not dress casually in the church. Since the changes in the Church, few parishes have any kind of dress code. Here, however, we still believe that modesty and appropriate attire are necessary, especially in Church out of reverence for the Blessed Sacrament. Please observe these minimum standards of dress for attendance at Church services:

- Women and girls must cover their heads. Chapel veils or mantillas are available for loan in the vestibule. They should also wear dresses or skirts that cover the knee completely when standing or sitting; slacks, shorts, sleeveless, tight or low cut clothing are not permitted.
- Men and boys should wear a suit coat and tie
- Jeans and other casual attire are inappropriate for attendance at Church services. ٠
- Also, unless you have been attending the Latin Mass exclusively, you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until you have had an opportunity to meet with Father.

Marylike Standards of Modesty in Dress

- 1. Marylike modest without is compromise, "like Mary," Christ's Mother.
- 2. Marylike dresses have sleeves extending at least to the elbows, and skirts reaching below the knees.
- 3. Marylike dresses require full coverage for the bodice, chest, shoulders and back; except for a cut-out about the neck not exceeding two inches below the neckline in front and in the back. and a corresponding two inches on the shoulders.
- Marylike dresses do not admit as 4. modest coverage transparent fabricslaces, nets, organdy, nylons, etc., -unless sufficient backing is added. However, their moderate use as trimmings is acceptable.
- Marvlike dresses avoid the improper 2. 5. use of flesh-colored fabrics.
- 6. Marylike dresses conceal rather than reveal the figure of the wearer; they do not emphasize, unduly, parts of the body.
- dresses 7. Marvlike provide full coverage, even after jacket, cape or stole are removed.
