

EMBER DAYS: This week we have the Ember Days for the spring season. There is no additional obligation for those bound to the Lenten fast; for those not bound to fast (such as those from 7-21 years old or over 59) there is the additional obligation to limit the use of meat on Wednesday and Saturday to the main meal only.

SEMINARY FUND-RAISER: Next Sunday the seminary will host a bake sale after both Masses, with "blarney stones" and other baked goods available.

CONFRATERNITY MEETING: There will be a meeting this Saturday, after Mass.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS are prayed every Friday of Lent at 11:00 am, followed by the distribution of Holy Communion.

LENTEN DEVOTIONS: The chaplet of Our Lady of Sorrows, followed by a brief Lenten sermon, is held every Wednesday of Lent at 7:15 pm in the seminary chapel.

LENTEN FAST: All adults between the ages of 21 and 60 are bound to fast on all the weekdays of Lent, beginning with Ash Wednesday and concluding on Holy Saturday, unless excused due to a health issue. If you are in doubt as to whether or not you are excused, please consult a priest. The Fast means there is no eating between meals, and only one full meal is allowed. Two smaller, meatless meals are permitted, as long as the combined amount of food consumed would not equal or exceed what is taken at a normal main meal.

MASS STIPENDS: Due to a large backlog of Mass intentions, we will not be able to accept any until further notice.

CHURCH REMODEL: Our remodeling project is entering the final stages, but it will still take about 4 weeks to complete. Let us pray for the men who are working on the church, that they will be kept safe and that Saint Joseph will guide them in their work.
