ASH WEDNESDAY: Blessed ashes will be distributed this Wednesday after the 6:30 am Mass and prior to the 10:30 am Mass. Also, Ash Wednesday is a day of total abstinence, which obliges all Catholics who are at least seven years of age. Let us all begin the season of Lent well!

STATIONS OF THE CROSS are prayed every Friday of Lent at 11:00 am, followed by the distribution of Holy Communion.

LENTEN DEVOTIONS: The chaplet of Our Lady of Sorrows, followed by a brief Lenten sermon, is held every Wednesday of Lent at 7:15 pm in the seminary chapel.

LENTEN FAST: All adults between the ages of 21 and 60 are bound to fast on all the weekdays of Lent, beginning with Ash Wednesday and concluding on Holy Saturday, unless excused due to a health issue. If you are in doubt as to whether or not you are excused, please consult a priest. The Fast means there is no eating between meals, and only one full meal is allowed. Two smaller, meatless meals are permitted, as long as the combined amount of food consumed would not equal or exceed what is taken at a normal main meal.

DAYLIGHT SAVINGS TIME begins next Sunday. Be sure to turn clocks ahead one hour Saturday night.
