ASH WEDNESDAY: This Wednesday is Ash Wednesday, the first day of Lent. It is a day of fast and total abstinence. Meat is not permitted at all on Wednesday. Blessed Ashes will be distributed after the 6:30 am Mass and also at the beginning of the 10:30 am High Mass. For those unable to receive them on Wednesday, blessed ashes will be distributed after all the Masses next Sunday.

LENTEN FAST begins this Wednesday and lasts until Easter. Every day of Lent, except Sundays is a day of fast. Those who are between the ages of 21 and 60 are bound to fast. Only three meals are permitted (no eating between meals). The two smaller meals must be meatless and, if combined, would not equal or exceed the amount taken at a normal main meal. Those who have a health condition that would prevent them from observing the fast should consult a priest, if there is any doubt as to your obligation. Expectant and nursing mothers are exempt from the Lenten Fast.

LENTEN DEVOTIONS: Every Wednesday of Lent there will be the recitation of the Sorrowful Mother chaplet at 7:15 pm in the seminary chapel, followed by a short Lenten sermon. On Fridays there will be the Stations of the Cross at 11:00 am, followed by the distribution of Holy Communion. There will also be the changing of Vespers every Sunday of Lent at 4:30 pm.

SEMINARY RETREAT: Our annual seminary retreat for Saint Joseph Seminary will begin this Friday evening and last until next Sunday afternoon. Please observe the spirit of silence here at the City of Mary next weekend, due to the retreat.

PARENTS: If you bring your small children to the communion rail when a visiting priest is having Mass, please be sure the priest knows which ones have not yet made their First Holy Communion.
