**PARISH BREAKFAST:** Today there will be a School-Support Breakfast after the 9:00 am Mass. Proceeds to the support of our school.

**EASTER DUTY:** We remind the faithful of their responsibility to receive Holy Communion during the Easter Time and to go to confession at least once a year. This very minimal duty is a mark of one's devotion to his Catholic Faith and is a serious obligation, binding under pain of mortal sin. The Easter Time in the United States begins on the First Sunday of Lent and concludes with Trinity Sunday—a period of 14 weeks.

**LENTEN DEVOTIONS:** Every Wednesday of Lent there will be the recitation on the Sorrowful Mother chaplet at 7:15 pm in the seminary chapel, followed by a short Lenten sermon. On Fridays there will be Stations

of the Cross at 11:00 am (10:20 am on First Friday), followed by the distribution of Holy Communion. There will also be the chanting of Vespers every Sunday of Lent at 4:30 pm.

**SPRING FORWARD:** Remember to turn your clocks ahead Saturday night so that you are on time for Mass next Sunday.

**LENTEN FAST:** Every day of Lent, except Sundays, is a day of fast. Those who are between the ages of 21 and 60 are bound to fast. Only three meals are permitted (no eating between meals). The two smaller meals must be meatless and, if combined, would not equal or exceed the amount taken at a normal main meal. Those who have a health condition that would prevent them from the fast should consult a priest, if there is any doubt as to your obligation. Expectant and nursing mothers are exempt from the Lenten Fast.
