

**WELCOME NEWCOMERS!**

If this is the first time you have attended the Traditional Latin Mass, you may have noticed that our parishioners do not dress casually in the church. Since the changes in the Church, few parishes have any kind of dress code. Here, however, we still believe that modesty and appropriate attire are necessary, especially in Church out of reverence for the Blessed Sacrament. Please observe these minimum standards of dress for attendance at Church services:

- Women and girls must cover their heads. Chapel veils or mantillas are available for loan in the vestibule. They should also wear dresses or skirts that cover the knee completely when standing or sitting; slacks, shorts, sleeveless, tight, or low-cut clothing are not permitted.
- Men and boys should wear a suit coat and tie.
- Jeans and other casual attire are inappropriate for attendance at Church services.
- Also, unless you have been attending the Latin Mass exclusively, you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until you have had an opportunity to meet with Father.

**SAINT MARY MAGDALEN, Penitent**

Saint Mary, whom Jesus converted, and who witnessed His last moments in company with Mary, His Mother, and St. John, the beloved disciple, was called Magdalen from the town of Magdala in Galilee. At least St. Clement of Alexandria and others identify the penitent woman who washed Jesus' feet with her tears with Mary Magdalen.

She was by descent a Galilean and followed Jesus with other devout women. Some also suppose that she was the same Mary who was the sister of Martha and Lazarus. After His Resurrection, Jesus appeared first to Mary Magdalen and then to His Apostles. It is an ancient tradition in Provence, France, that Saint Mary Magdalen, or Mary the sister of Lazarus, together with Lazarus, Martha and some other disciples of Our Lord, being expelled by the Jews, put to sea and landed at Marseilles; and that St. Lazarus became the first Bishop of that See. The feast of St. Mary Magdalen is celebrated by the Greeks, as well as the Latins on July 22<sup>nd</sup>.

Save me from every danger that confronts me in life, and help me at the hour of death, that so I may come in safety to paradise, there to sing with thee, O most happy mother, the praises of the Word of God made Man in the womb of thy most pure daughter, the Virgin Mary.
