

WELCOME NEWCOMERS!

If this is the first time you have attended the Traditional Latin Mass, you may have noticed that our parishioners do not dress casually in the church. Since the changes in the Church, few parishes have any kind of dress code. Here, however, we still believe that modesty and appropriate attire are necessary, especially in Church out of reverence for the Blessed Sacrament. Please observe these minimum standards of dress for attendance at Church services:

- Women and girls must cover their heads. Chapel veils or mantillas are available for loan in the vestibule. They should also wear dresses or skirts that cover the knee completely when standing or sitting; slacks, shorts, sleeveless, tight, or low-cut clothing are not permitted.
- Men and boys should wear a suit coat and tie.
- Jeans and other casual attire are inappropriate for attendance at Church services.
- Also, unless you have been attending the Latin Mass exclusively, you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until you have had an opportunity to meet with Father.

**SAINTS COSMAS AND DAMIAN, Martyrs
September 27 – Patrons of Druggists**

Saints Cosmas and Damian were brothers, born in Arabia, who had become eminent for their skill in the science of medicine. Being Christians, they were filled with the spirit of charity and never took money for their services. At Egaea in Cilicia, where they lived, they enjoyed the highest esteem of the people. When the persecution under Diocletian broke out, their very prominence rendered them marked objects of persecution. Being apprehended by order of Lysias, Governor of Cilicia, they underwent various torments and were finally beheaded about the year 283.

**SAINTS ISAAC JOGUES, JOHN DE BREBEUF AND COMPANIONS, Martyrs
September 26**

Saints Isaac Jogues, John de Brebeuf, Charles Garnier, Anthony Daniel, Gabriel Lallemand, Noel Chabanel, John de Lalande and Rene Goupil, French Jesuits, were among the missionaries who preached the gospel to Huron and Iroquois Indians in the United States and Canada. They were martyred by the Iroquois Indians in the years 1642, 1648, and 1649. Pope Pius XI beatified them on June 21, 1925, and in 1930 they were canonized by the same Pope.

St. Isaac Jogues, in particular is outstanding because after spending thirteen months in slavery and being rescued by the Dutch, he returned after two years to Canada, and in 1646 visited Auriesville, New York to negotiate peace with the Iroquois. He is said to be the first Catholic priest to set foot on Manhattan Island. After a third visit to the Iroquois he was seized, tortured and beheaded.

PRAYER: *O God, Thou who hast consecrated the first fruits of the faith in the northern parts of America by the preaching and blood shed by Thy Blessed Martyrs Isaac, John and their Companions; grant, we beseech Thee, in Thy mercy and through their intercession, that the fruitful harvest of Christians may increase from day to day.
