If this is the first time you have attended the Traditional Latin Mass, you may have noticed that our parishioners do not dress casually in the church. Since the changes in the Church, few parishes have any kind of dress code. Here, however, we still believe that modesty and appropriate attire are necessary, especially in Church out of reverence for the Blessed Sacrament. Please observe these minimum standards of dress for attendance at Church services:

- Women and girls must cover their heads. Chapel veils or mantillas are available for loan in the vestibule. They should also
 wear dresses or skirts that cover the knee completely when standing or sitting; slacks, shorts, sleeveless, tight, or low-cut
 clothing are not permitted.
- Men and boys should wear a suit coat and tie.
- Jeans and other casual attire are inappropriate for attendance at Church services.
- Also, unless you have been attending the Latin Mass exclusively, you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until you
 have had an opportunity to meet with Father.

RACCOLTA #395

a) The faithful, whenever they recite a third part of the Rosary with devotion, may gain:

An indulgence of 5 years. A plenary indulgence on the usual conditions, if they do this for an entire month.

c) Those who piously recite a third part of the Rosary in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament publicly exposed or even reserved in the tabernacle, as often as they do this, may gain: A plenary indulgence, on the condition of confession and Communion.

NOTE: 1. The decades may be separated, if the entire chaplet is completed on the same day.

2. If, as is the custom during recitation of the Rosary, the faithful make use of a chaplet, they may gain other indulgences in addition to those enumerated above.

NOTE: See <u>Raccolta</u>, #395 for item b), which was too lengthy to fit here.

The 15 Promises Our Lady made to St. Dominic and Bl. Alan de la Roche for those who say the Rosary.

- To all those who shall recite my Rosary devoutly, I promise my special protection and very great graces.
- 2. Those who shall persevere in the recitation of my Rosary shall receive some signal grace.
- 3. The Rosary shall be a very powerful armor against hell; it will destroy vice, deliver from sin, and dispel heresy.
- 4. The Rosary will make virtue and good works flourish and will obtain for souls the most abundant divine mercies; it will substitute in hearts love of God for love of the world and will lift them to the desire of heavenly and eternal things. How many souls shall sanctify themselves by this means!
- Those who trust themselves to me through the Rosary, shall not perish.
- 6. Those who shall recite my Rosary devoutly, meditating on its mysteries, shall not be overwhelmed by misfortune. The sinner shall be converted; the just shall grow in grace and become worthy of eternal life.
- 7. Those truly devoted to my Rosary shall not die without the Sacraments of the Church.
- Those who recite my Rosary shall find during their life and at their death the light of God, the fullness of His graces, and shall share in the merits of the blessed.
- I shall deliver very promptly from purgatory the souls devoted to my Rosary.
- The true children of my Rosary shall enjoy great glory in heaven.
- 11. What you ask through my Rosary, you shall obtain.
- 12. Those who propagate my Rosary shall be aided by me in all their necessities.
- I have obtained from my Divine Son that all the advocates of the Rosary shall have for intercessors the entire celestial court during their life and at the hour of death.
