

WELCOME NEWCOMERS!

If this is the first time you have attended the Traditional Latin Mass, you may have noticed that our parishioners do not dress casually in the church. Since the changes in the Church, few parishes have any kind of dress code. Here, however, we still believe that modesty and appropriate attire are necessary, especially in Church out of reverence for the Blessed Sacrament. Please observe these minimum standards of dress for attendance at Church services:

- Women and girls must cover their heads. Chapel veils or mantillas are available for loan in the vestibule. They should also wear dresses or skirts that cover the knee completely when standing or sitting; slacks, shorts, sleeveless, tight, or low-cut clothing are not permitted.
- Men and boys should wear a suit coat and tie.
- Jeans and other casual attire are inappropriate for attendance at Church services.
- Also, unless you have been attending the Latin Mass exclusively, you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until you have had an opportunity to meet with Father.

**SAINT FRANCIS DE SALES
Bishop, Confessor & Doctor of the Church
Patron of Writers – January 29**

St. Francis was born near Annecy in Savoy, in 1567. Showing an early inclination for the ecclesiastical state, he received tonsure at eleven years of age. Soon after he was sent to Paris to study philosophy and theology. At the University of Padua he was honored with a doctorate in both canon and civil law. Having completed his studies at the University, he entered the priesthood. Shortly after he took upon himself the arduous mission of Chablais, where Calvinism had obtained a strong hold. In the midst of the enormous difficulties, he pursued his labors with apostolic heroism. While engaged in this work he received his appointment as coadjutor to the Bishop of Geneva, whom he succeeded as Bishop in 1602.

He now began to labor zealously in his diocese for the clergy and people, and extended his labors elsewhere, preaching the Lenten sermons at various places outside of the diocese. He also composed several instructive works for the edification of the faithful. In 1610 he founded the Order of the Visitation, with the help of the Baroness de Chantal, now St. Jane Frances.

Finally the day arrived for which his whole life had been a preparation. His characteristic virtue was meekness; he bore the greatest insults, even from his inferiors, with the deepest humility. He died at Lyons, December 28, 1642, in the pontificate of Gregory XV and the reign of Louis XII of France. He was canonized by Alexander VI in 1665; and in 1877 Pios IX placed him among the Doctors of the Church.
