

WELCOME NEWCOMERS!

If this is the first time you have attended the Traditional Latin Mass, you may have noticed that our parishioners do not dress casually in the church. Since the changes in the Church, few parishes have any kind of dress code. Here, however, we still believe that modesty and appropriate attire are necessary, especially in Church out of reverence for the Blessed Sacrament. Please observe these minimum standards of dress for attendance at Church services:

- Women and girls must cover their heads. Chapel veils or mantillas are available for loan in the vestibule. They should also wear dresses or skirts that cover the knee completely when standing or sitting; slacks, shorts, sleeveless, tight, or low-cut clothing are not permitted.
- Men and boys should wear a suit coat and tie.
- Jeans and other casual attire are inappropriate for attendance at Church services.
- Also, unless you have been attending the Latin Mass exclusively, you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until you have had an opportunity to meet with Father.

DEVOUT EXERCISES

Raccolta #379

The faithful who, between three o’clock on the afternoon of Good Friday and noon of the following day, spend some time in devout meditation or offer some prayers, either in public or in private, in honor of the B.V.M. Sorrowing, may gain: *A plenary indulgence on the usual conditions.*

Those who at other seasons of the year perform the same devout exercises between three o’clock on Friday afternoon and noon of the following Sunday, may gain: *An indulgence of 5 years; A plenary indulgence on the usual conditions, if they perform this devout exercise each week for a month.*

ACT OF ADORATION – Raccolta #145

The faithful who devoutly visit the Blessed Sacrament in the repository on Holy Thursday or Good Friday, and recite *Our Father, Hail Mary* and *Glory Be*, five times in order to return due thanks for the institution of the Holy Eucharist, and one *Our Father, Hail Mary* and *Glory be* for the intentions of Holy Mother the Church, are granted: *An indulgence of 15 years; A plenary indulgence once each day, if in addition to confession they partake of the Eucharistic table.*

Raccolta #214

O Jesus, Who by reason of Thy burning love for us hast willed to be crucified and to shed Thy Most Precious Blood for the redemption and salvation of our souls, look down upon us here gathered together in remembrance of Thy most sorrowful Passion and Death, fully trusting in Thy mercy; cleanse us from sin by Thy grace, sanctify our toil, give unto us and unto all those who are dear to us our daily bread, sweeten our sufferings, bless our families, and to the nations so sorely afflicted, grant Thy peace which is the only true peace, so that by obeying Thy commandments we may come at last to the glory of heaven. Amen.

The faithful, who recite this prayer with devotion at three o’clock on Good Friday, the hour when Our Lord Jesus Christ expired on the Cross, are granted: *An indulgence of 500 days.*
